




Market Summary

The stock market on Monday remained bullish throughout the day and concluded the session in the green zone amid a high-level Saudi business delegation arrived in Pakistan on Sunday to sign agreements and MoUs for investment in different sectors. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 73,060.74 (1,158.65 points) and 72,462.49 (560.40) respectively while closed at 72,764.24 by gaining 862.15 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs 0.0277 against USD and closed at Rs 278.2374. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs24.503 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs9.885 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 578.06 million shares compared with Friday's tally of 449.04 million. PAEL was the volume leader with 48.4 million shares, gaining Rs1.74 to close at Rs25.13. It was followed by FCCL with 40.4 million shares, gaining Rs1.08 to close at Rs22.44 and KEL with 26.8 million shares, gaining Rs0.05 to close at Rs4.41
