




### **Market Summary**

The stock market on Thursday remained positive throughout the day and concluded the session in the green zone amid optimism prevailing among the investors over positive macroeconomic fundamentals. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 92,694.53 (673.09 points) and 92,185.69 (164.25 points) respectively while closed at 92,520.48 by gaining 499.04 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs 0.0538 against USD and closed at Rs277.9461. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs24.823 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs11.874 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 678.63 million shares compared with Wednesday's tally of 888.83 million. BOP was the volume leader with 62.9 million shares, gaining Rs0.36 to close at Rs6.57. It was followed by KOSM with 46.5 million shares, gaining Rs0.54 to close at Rs7.83 and KEL with 34.7 million shares, gaining Rs0.16 to close at Rs4.8.


