
Market Summary

The stock market on Tuesday remained volatile throughout the day and concluded the session in the red zone amid a chorus of political dissent and discord prevailing in the country. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 64,786.35 (549.33 points) and 63,878.21 (358.81 points) respectively while closed at 64,170.57 by losing 66.45 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.06 against USD and closed at Rs 281.2220. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs12.2 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs 9.308 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 447.7 million shares compared with Monday's tally of 483.9 million.KEL was the volume leader with 114 million shares, losing Rs0.15 to close at Rs5.75. It was followed by HASCOLDEF with 36.1 million shares, gaining Rs0.45 to close at Rs8 and PIAA with 19.8 million shares, gaining Rs0.63 to close at Rs8.99.
