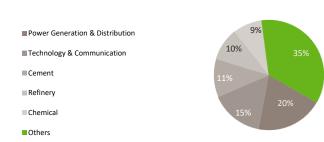

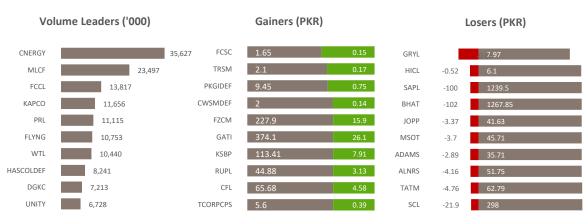
Market Summary

The stock market on Thursday remained positive throughout the day and concluded the session in the green zone amid optimism over the economic situation after the revival of the IMF programmme. The benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 42,667 (316 points) and 42,351 (0 points) respectively while closed at 42,460 by gaining 109 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated Rs0.15 against USD and closed at 218.60. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 8.015 billion. Market capitalization stood at around 7.043 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 243 million shares compared with Wednesday's tally of 181 million. CNERGY was the volume leader with 35.6 million shares, losing Rs0.04 to close at Rs5.32. It was followed by MLCF with 23.5 million shares, gaining Rs0.27 to close at Rs28.89, and FCCL with 13.8 million shares, gaining Rs0.44 to close at Rs15.46.

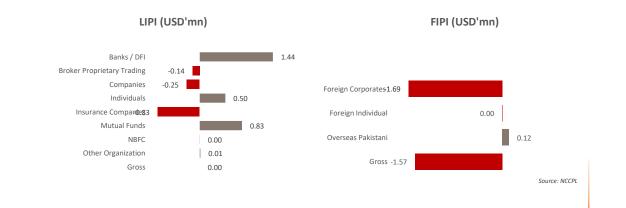
