
Market Summary

The stock market on Wednesday Surged over 300 points and concluded the session in the green zone amid IMF expects faster economic recovery at 2.5pc this year. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 48,516.64 (376 points) and 48,208.30 (68 points) respectively while closed at 48,474.54 by gaining 334 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs0.99 against USD and closed at Rs279.51. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 10.522 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs7.140 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 396 million shares compared with Tuesday's tally of 349 million. KEL was the volume leader with 145.1 million shares, gaining Rs0.29 to close at Rs2.75. It was followed by PRL with 18.1 million shares, gaining Rs0.76 to close at Rs26.26.
