

## **Market Summary**


The stock market on Thursday Surged over 700 points and concluded the session in the green zone by making an all-time high by crossing the 57000 physiological level amid IMF & Pakistan authorities reached a staff-level agreement on the first review of Stand-By Arrangement. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 57,549.26 (869 points) and 56,531.53 (-149 points) respectively while closed at 57,397.02 by gaining 717 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs0.77 against USD and closed at Rs287.37. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 28.826 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs8.295 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 1053 million shares compared with Wednesday's tally of 661 million. WTL was the volume leader with 386.4 million shares, gaining Rs0.19 to close at Rs1.59. It was followed by CNERGY with 45.1 million shares, losing Rs0.04 to close at Rs4.7, and PRL with 39.6 million shares, gaining Rs0.73 to close at Rs24.97.
