

Market Summary


The stock market on Wednesday remained positive throughout the day and concluded the session up in the green zone amid MCB posts highest-ever PAT of Rs28.67bn in 1HCY23. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 48,852.05 (622 points) and 48,178.88 (-52 points) respectively while closed at 48,765 by gaining 534 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs1.84 against USD and closed at Rs289.38. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs19.983 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs7.336 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 556 million shares compared with Tuesday's tally of 554 million. CNERGY was the volume leader with 92.9 million shares, gaining Rs0.24 to close at Rs3.75. It was followed by BOP with 47 million shares, gaining Rs0.26 to close at Rs4.82 and PRL with 31.3 million shares, gaining Rs0.64 to close at Rs18.4.
