



### **Market Summary**

The stock market on Monday continued its upward momentum throughout the day and concluded the session in the green zone. The benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 41,027 (607 points) and 40,348 (-71 points) respectively while closed at 40,815 by gaining 395 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs0.02 against USD and closed at Rs226.43. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs7.278 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs6.544 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 242 million shares compared with Friday's tally of 284 million. PPL was the volume leader with 15 million shares, gaining Rs3.23 to close at Rs71.37. It was followed by PRL with 12.7 million shares, gaining Rs0.59 to close at Rs13.56, and HASCOLDEF with 12.2 million shares, gaining Rs1 to close at Rs6.61.
