






Market Summary

The stock market on Wednesday remained volatile throughout the day and concluded the session in the red zone amid rupee slips lower against US dollar in open market. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intraday high and low at 46,035.09 (124.63 points) and 45,808.10 (-102 points) respectively while closed at 45,889.57 by losing 20.89 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs1.02 against USD and closed at Rs293.88. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 3.636 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs6.800 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 129 million shares compared with Tuesday's tally of 117 million. TREET was the volume leader with 17.8 million shares, gaining Rs0.56 to close at Rs17.12. It was followed by SEARLR2 with 16 million shares, losing Rs0.52 to close at Rs0.25 and PPL with 6.1 million shares, losing Rs1.52 to close at Rs71.62.
