




Market Summary


The stock market on Tuesday remained negative throughout the day and concluded the session in the red zone amid Moody's said Pakistan's government liquidity and external vulnerability risks remain very volatile. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 63,622.00 (316.07 points) and 63,055.64 (-250.29 points) respectively while closed at 63,219.09 by losing -86.84 points.PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs 0.0764 against USD and closed at Rs 279.2764. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs14.669 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs 9.073 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 409.86 million shares compared with Monday's tally of 452.64 million. BOP was the volume leader with 47.6 million shares, gaining Rs0.02 to close at Rs6.27. It was followed by KEL with 40.6 million shares, gaining Rs0.08 to close at Rs4.52 and WTL with 25.8 million shares, losing Rs0.04 to close at Rs1.27.
