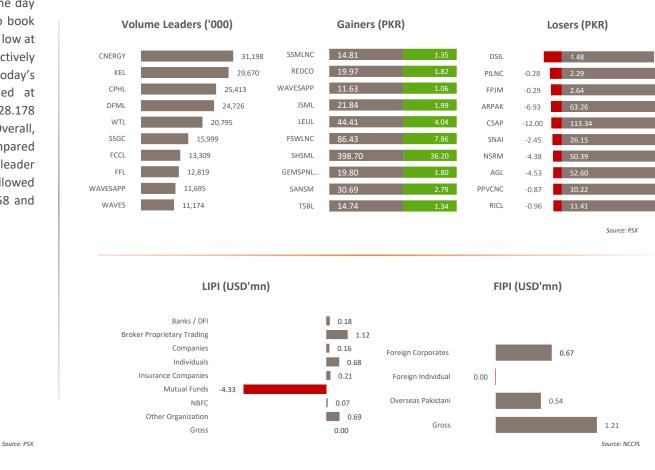
### **Market Summary**

The stock market on Wednesday remained volatile throughout the day and concluded the session in the red zone as investors opted to book profits. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 112,569.89 (539.53 points) and 111,157.18 (-873.18 points) respectively while closed at 111,487.36 by losing 543.00 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.0522 against USD and closed at Rs278.8728. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs28.178 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs13.736 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 448.46 million shares compared with Tuesday's tally of 516.18 million. CNERGY was the volume leader with 31.2 million shares, gaining Rs0.17 to close at Rs7.53. It was followed by KEL with 29.7 million shares, gaining Rs0.09 to close at Rs4.58 and CPHL with 25.4 million shares, losing Rs0.4 to close at Rs93.26.
