




## **Market Summary**

The stock market on Thursday remained volatile throughout the day and concluded the session a bit above its previous closing amid the uncertain macroeconomic situation prevailing in the country. The benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 41,936 (171 points) and 41,677 (-89 points) respectively while closed at 41,825 by gaining 59 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated Rs2.0 against USD and closed at 225.42. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 4.391 billion. Market capitalization stood at around 6.935 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 109 million shares compared with Wednesday's tally of 93 million. MLCF was the volume leader with 8.4 million shares, gaining Rs0.89 to close at Rs28.65. It was followed by LOTCHEM with 6.7 million shares, gaining Rs1.32 to close at Rs30.11, and HASCOLDEF with 5.5 million shares, gaining Rs0.01 to close at Rs6.97.
