Market Summary

The stock market on Wednesday remained volatile throughout the day concluded the session in the red zone amid macroeconomic uncertainties. The benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 42,195 (40 points) and 41,950 (-204 points) respectively while closed at 42,007 by losing 148 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated 9 paisas against USD and closed at 217.88. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 7.843 billion. Market capitalization stood at around 6.837 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 238 million shares compared with Tuesday's tally of 305 million. KEL was the volume leader with 34.4 million shares, gaining Rs0.1 to close at Rs3.06. It was followed by WTL with 30.5 million shares, losing Rs0.05 to close at Rs1.51, and TELE with 16.3 million shares, gaining Rs0.36 to close at Rs11.66.

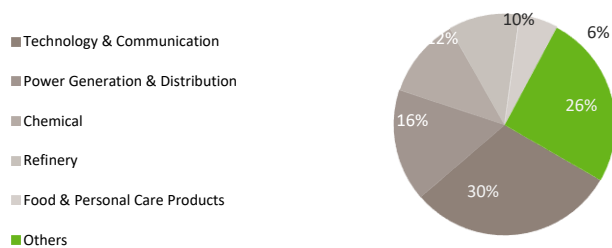

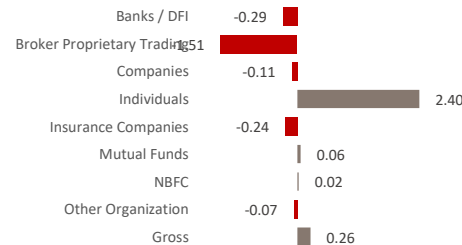

Overall Sector Turnover (%)

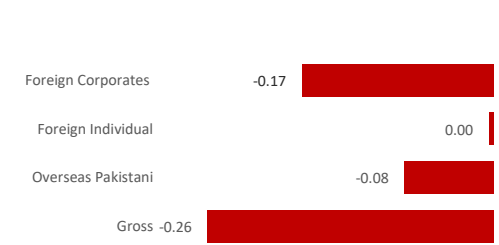

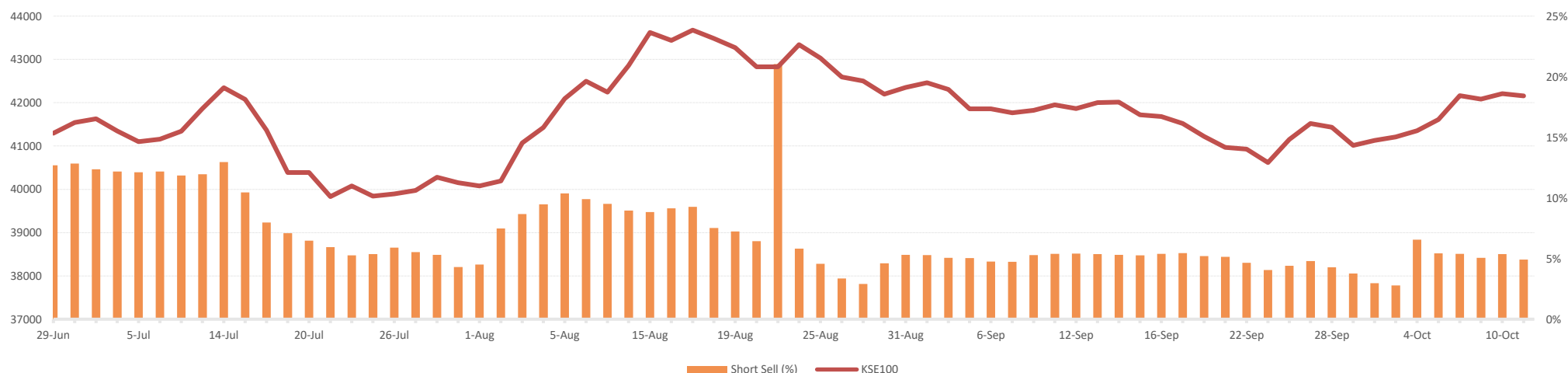
