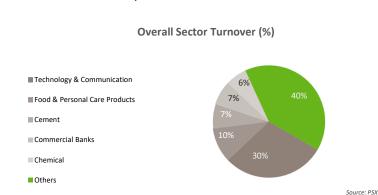

Market Summary

The stock market on Monday remained negative throughout the day and concluded the session in the red zone amid growing trade deficit and inflation raise concerns among investors. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 169,326.35 (336.28 points) and 165,997.36 (-2,992.71 points) respectively while closed at 167,752.40 by losing 1,237.67 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.0088 against USD and closed at Rs281.2539. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 60.469 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs19.382 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 1270.73 million shares compared with Friday tally of 1571.35 million. BOP was the volume leader with 131.3 million shares, gaining Rs0.96 to close at Rs34.46. It was followed by KEL with 110 million shares, losing Rs0.09 to close at Rs7.02 and BML with 78.3 million shares,gaining Rs0.48 to close at Rs8.29.

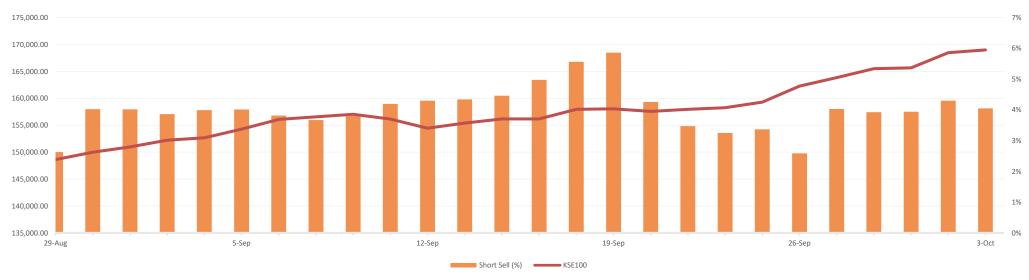
