

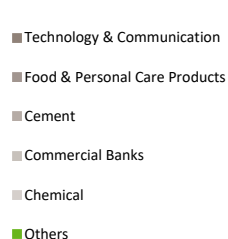

Market Summary

The stock market on Wednesday plunged over 6,500 points in the opening note. However, half of its earlier losses were recovered in the second half and concluded the session in the red zone amid border battles intensify as India and Pakistan face off in the most severe confrontation in more than two decades. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 112,457.37 (1,111.13 points) and 107,007.68 (6,560.82 points) respectively while closed at 110,009.02 by losing 3,559.48 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs 0.0987 against USD and closed at Rs281.4722. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs30.08 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs13.343 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 547.45 million shares compared with Tuesday's tally of 419.89 million. WTL was the volume leader with 53.7 million shares, losing Rs0.11 to close at Rs1.22. It was followed by BOP with 35.8 million shares, losing Rs0.61 to close at Rs9.18 and SSGC with 26.7 million shares, losing Rs3.61 to close at Rs32.47.

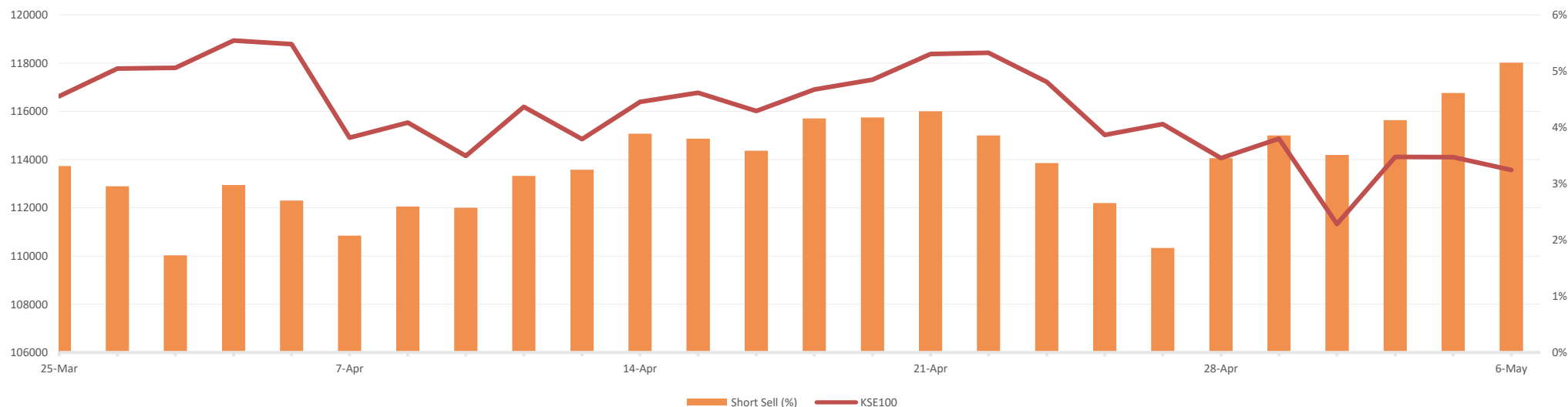
