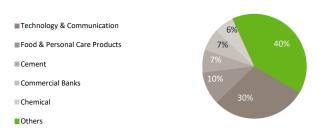

Market Summary

The stock market on Friday remained volatile throughout day and concluded the session in the red zone as investors engaged in profittaking. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 165,262.85 (732.05 points) and 162,411.25 (-2,119.55 points) respectively while closed at 163,098.19 by losing 1,432.61 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.0287 against USD and closed at Rs281.1728. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 47.734 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs18.903 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 1397.25 million shares compared with Thursday tally of 1568.34 million. KEL was the volume leader with 200 million shares, gaining Rs0.21 to close at Rs7.13. It was followed by WTL with 143.9 million shares, losing Rs0.04 to close at Rs1.73 and BOP with 90.2 million shares, losing Rs0.8 to close at Rs32.07.

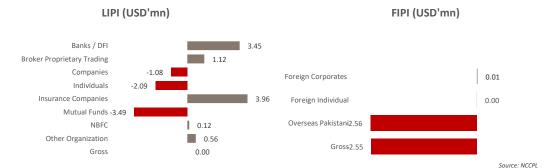

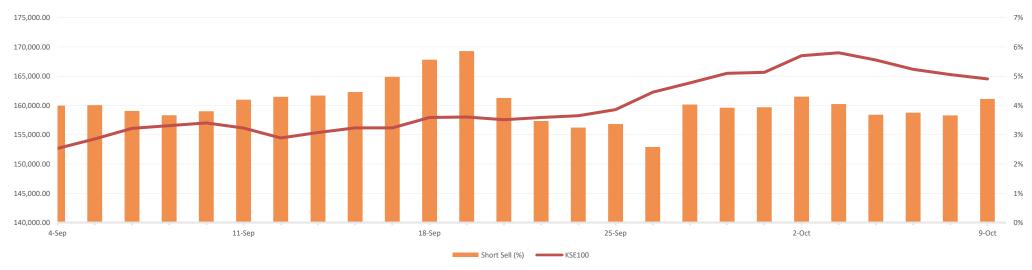
