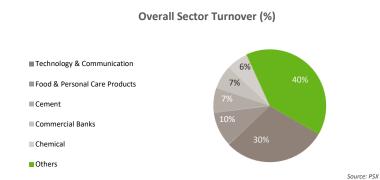

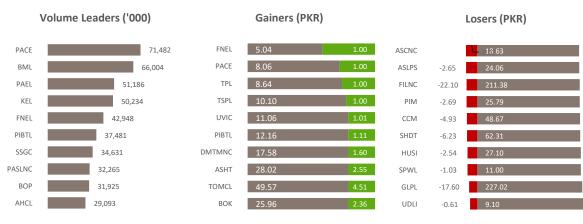

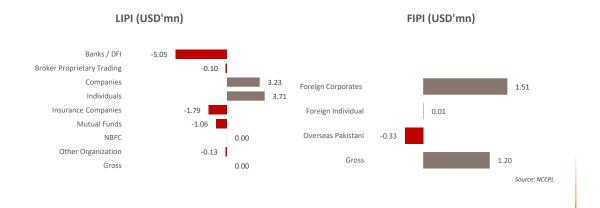
Market Summary

The stock market on Thursday remained positive in the first half, followed by selling in the second half and concluded the session in the red zone amid cautious sentiments prevailing among the investors. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 148,042.00 (547.97 points) and 147,209.55 (-284.48 points) respectively while closed at 147,343.50 by losing 150.53 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.025 against USD and closed at Rs281.8039. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 33.498 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs17.534 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 934.44 million shares compared with Wednesday tally of 854.85 million. PACE was the volume leader with 71.5 million shares, gaining Rs1 to close at Rs8.06. It was followed by BML with 66 million shares, gaining Rs0.52 to close at Rs5.81 and PAEL with 51.2 million shares, gaining Rs1.77 to close at Rs46.83.
