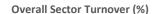

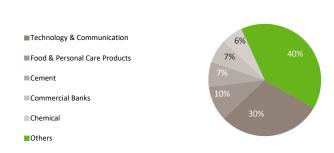

Market Summary

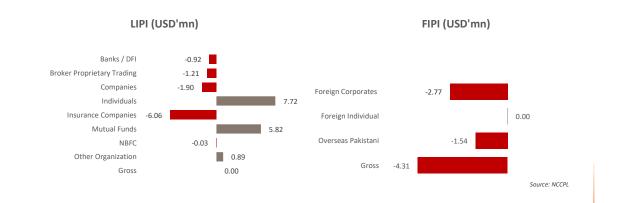
The stock market on Monday surged past the 163,000 mark and concluded the session in the green zone amid IMF mission led by Chief Iva Petrova is in Islamabad to discuss the second Extended Fund Facility and the first Resilience and Sustainability Facility review. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 163,903.62 (1,646.62 points) and 162,058.64 (-198.36 points) respectively while closed at 163,847.68 by gaining 1,590.68 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.0171 against USD and closed at Rs281.3539. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 65.710 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs19.154 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 1282.18 million shares compared with Friday tally of 1709.54 million. WTL was the volume leader with 118.9 million shares, losing Rs0.03 to close at Rs1.82. It was followed by KEL with 78.2 million shares, gaining Rs0.02 to close at Rs7.15 and HASCOLNC with 63.5 million shares, losing Rs0.41 to close at Rs13.67.
